Hidden Sins

Psalm 19:12 Who can discern his errors? Forgive my hidden faults.

From the song Purer In Heart, O God is a phrase that will be considered today. In the song, part of one verse goes, "Keep me from secret sin, Reign Thou my soul within, Purer in heart, help me to be. Is it possible to sin and not really know that you are sinning? This is certainly a possibility. The Psalmist is making this cry in the twelfth verse. He prays that God will forgive his hidden faults. Sometimes we are so deceived that we do not realize that we sin. Sometimes we are ignorant of God's word and violate his commands. Sometimes we rationalize away our behavior and think our actions are acceptable. Secret sins are not those hidden from others nor does it mean sins performed secretly. Secret sins are those that we commit but are unaware that we have transgressed God's laws.

At the end of the day, do we reflect upon our actions? Have I been careless in the treatment of other people? Did I have an opportunity to do good and let it pass by? Was evil found in my heart and I did not recognize it? Did I speak careless or idle words? Were evil thoughts found in my heart? We need to continually ask God to forgive us of all sins and we need to pray that our eyes will be opened to anything that is offensive to God in our lives. Once again the need to know God's word is great. Sometimes by simply knowing his word we will find the need to change our behavior. We must strive to have good behavior without neglecting such things as love, kindness, self-control, patience, gentleness as well as others. May each one of us grow purer in heart and increase in holy behavior.
