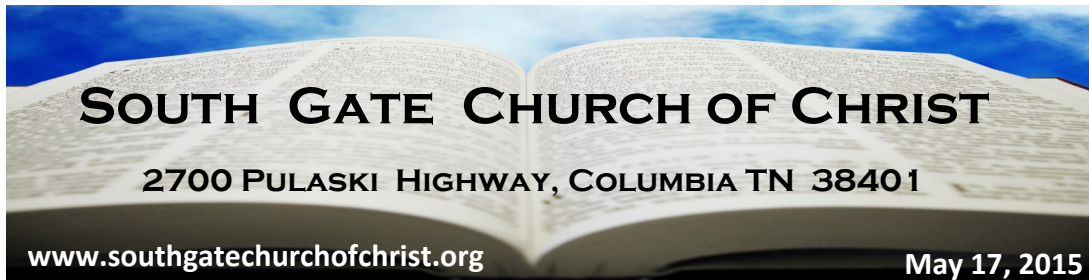

Gary was made a deacon in 1999. For several years he has served as the director of Working For The Master. Previously he served as deacon over the mission work.

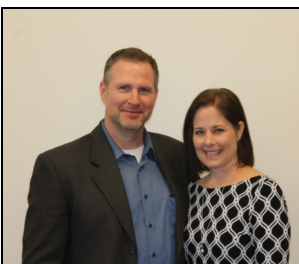


Jason Kelley
