⁶ These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart. ⁷ You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up.

Deuteronomy 6:6,7

Counsel For Teens

Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

Young people need lots of guidance. Solomon wrote the book of Proverbs for his son to be able to determine what proper living is all about. Excellent behavior as well as bad behavior is presented in his wisdom. While the lessons are many and varied, it all begins with wisdom. This information must be presented to our young people.

Today's verse shows where wisdom begins. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom. This fact must be impressed upon our children. Living the best life possible begins with knowing what God wants and expects from us. We spare ourselves from so many bad consequences when we seek God's wisdom. At the same time that we proclaim the fear of the Lord we must teach our children to not fear man. Proverbs 29:25 states, "Fear of man will prove to be a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord is kept safe." Men can be mean and evil but we must fear the Lord rather than them. God comes first in our daily living. We must obey God rather than men. The third thought comes from Proverbs 28:26. "He who trusts in himself is a fool, but he who walks in wisdom is kept safe." Man places a lot of faith in himself. We trust our judgment and believe we always have our best interests at heart. When we do this, Solomon declared we are a fool. This is contrary to the way man thinks but this is the way of life. Simply put, Solomon says to fear God, don't fear man and don't trust vourself. This is wise counsel for all people.
