Abuse In The Family

Luke 11:46 And you experts in the law, woe to you, because you load people down with burdens they can hardly carry, and you yourselves will not lift one finger to help them.

The home should not be a place for abuse. On occasion a parent can take advantage of their children and make life miserable. This should not be. Parents are to be the good example for their children. The verse above is about religious abuse but is applicable to the family. Do not put a load on your children that you yourself are unwilling to bear. Stand beside your children when the load is heavy and help them. Christ condemned powerful people who used others. Physical and emotional abuses have no part in a Christian's life.

Elders are warned the same. In the list of characteristics we read that they are not to be violent but gentle. They should not be guarrelsome but respectable and able to teach. In Malachi, God stated that he hated divorce and a man covering himself with violence. Divorce is sinful and spousal abuse is sinful. Consider some of the aspects of love found in I Corinthians 13. Love is patient and kind. It is not rude or self-seeking. Love is not easily angered. Power and the desire to stay in power leads many to succumb to abuse. Power always carries a responsibility. We are to protect the weak and those under our control. This is God's way. If you find yourself in this situation, then repent. Jeremiah told Israelites to really change your ways and your actions and deal with each other justly. This will be pleasing to God.
