#### MISSION WORK SUPPORTED BY SOUTH GATE

This week we will focus on the mission work of some of our members. This year there will be over 30 people from our congregation involved in foreign missions. Mike Lyle has just returned from Guyana where he worked with a men in preaching school to help them improve their English language skills. These are men who have taken a huge step to give up their regular jobs and to leave their home to study the Bible intensively for two years with the goal of returning to their home villages to start or grow new congregations. They can speak English rather well, but struggle considerably when it comes to reading the Scriptures for themselves and figuring out the messages they contain.

On June 27<sup>th</sup> a large group from South Gate will be leaving to spend a week working at the City of Children in Ensenada, Mexico. The purpose of the City of Children is to teach the gospel of our Lord to the orphaned and needy children of Mexico. One of the ways that is accomplished is through providing mission opportunities for visiting teams from Churches of Christ. The purpose of a visit is to be a friend and an example of Jesus to a child. A few of our members also went to the City of Children this spring with a group from CA.

Baylie Farris has also been involved in foreign missions this year. She was able to travel to the Dominican Republic to participate in a mission effort with a group from Freed-Hardeman. Trey Newport, the son of Kim Morgan, has also spent time on the Caribbean island of Saba doing mission work this year. Trey has been involved in work in Saba for a few years now. Please give thanks to God for the successful efforts that have already taken place and continue to pray for those who will be traveling soon to help grow our Lord's church.
