## What It Is All About

I Corinthians 2:2 For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified.

Paul spent each and every day of his life after becoming a Christian talking to people about their soul. He desired that people submit to God's plan of salvation. What was his message that he spoke to individuals and to congregations? The message is all about Jesus Christ and what he did. He would tell of Jesus coming to this world. Then the message was about his earthly life - especially his three year ministry. He would tell of Jesus healing the sick, giving sight to the blind and even raising the dead. The parables he spoke would be repeated along with the meaning intended by Jesus. Paul would then lead up to the death of Jesus on the cross. The reason for the crucifixion was explained and the resurrection was told in amazement. What is the gospel? It is simply the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus. This is what Paul proclaimed to the Corinthians and to every new city that he entered.

This is the same message that we need to proclaim in this day and time. We must talk about proper living and holiness. We have to explain the church and its organization. It is so important to talk about worship but all of this comes after we help people understand who Jesus is and what he has done for us. Jesus is the Son of God and he sacrificed his life for us on the cross. When this is deeply understood then the other becomes a necessary part of instruction.
