### **Much More Valuable**

Matthew 12:12 How much more valuable is a man than a sheep! Therefore it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath.

A dog was dug out of a deep pit - a doe caught in a fence - a cat up a tree - an eagle whose wing was broken - puppies abandoned on a road - all stories where a person or people go to great lengths to help an animal. Jesus was strongly condemned by the Pharisees for healing a man with a shriveled hand on the Sabbath. They didn't mind that he healed a man. They were upset with his timing. He was considered to be a lawbreaker by the Pharisees. Jesus had a greater concern. What is the value of a man? When is the right time to help a human in trouble? People are far more valuable than animals. The right time to help is now. When we realize the value of a person and the soul then we will quickly spring to action to help, especially in connection with things eternal. It is never wrong to help our fellow man. We should greatly appreciate the message our Lord delivered and then backed up with his sacrifice on the cross. People are valuable!
