Can we say that I don't care what I am able to do in heaven, just let me be there? I want to be with God

Never forget that God does not withhold any good thing from those whose way is blameless. Let's watch how we walk so that one day we will hear him say, "Well done my good and faithful servant. Come and share your master's happiness." Will I be in heaven?
