#### A Way Out

I Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has seized you expect what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

Temptation is not a sin. Jesus was tempted by Satan while he was fasting in the wilderness. However, he did not given in to the temptations. He remained free from sin. All people will face temptations. What will we do with faced with them? Alcohol is a temptation for many but for some it is not. Gossiping is a temptation for some and not for others.
