### Making A Vow

**Ecclesiastes 5:4** When you make a vow to God, do not delay in fulfilling it. He has no pleasure in fools; fulfill your vow.

Have you ever made a promise to God? Did you keep your word? Any time we make a promise we are to fulfill it. God is well aware of the promise that we have made. Once the vow is made we should set out to fulfill it as quickly as possible. Do not put it off to another day when it is in your power to act. Delays could lead to a change in circumstances that make it difficult to fulfill the promise. Delays could lead to forgetfulness. Promises are often made in times of stress and when the strain is removed then it becomes difficult to keep our word.

Scriptures warn us about taking vows to God. Solomon declared that it is better to not make a vow than to make one and not fulfill it. We need to be wise in the use of our tongue. Solomon warned about not allowing our mouth to lead us into sin. Making a vow and failing to fulfill it is sin. God then views us as a fool. There is no good reason to place ourselves in this situation. Furthermore, being in this state leads God to be angry with us. God's people are expected to keep their word.

Solomon's final warning in this section is to stand in awe of God. God keeps his word and as his people we are expected to do the same. God blesses us for obedience. Have you made any promises that you have not kept? If so, then get started now.
