Deuteronomy 31: 6 "Be strong and courageous, do not be afraid or tremble at them, for the Lord your God is the one who goes with you. He will not fail you or forsake you."

He Tends His Flocks

Isaiah 40:11 *He tends his flock like a shepherd: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them close to his heart; he gently leads those that have young.*

Reading this reminds me of a picture that used to hang on the wall of my parent's home as I was growing up. It was a painting of Jesus gently clutching a young lamb to his chest. The picture portrays the image of love, caring, compassion and gentleness. A shepherd cares about the entire flock but is especially mindful of the young lambs. Sheep need to be led to green pastures and clean water. Sheep need protection and the shepherd is willing to provide it even at the risk of his own life. The fact is that shepherds love their sheep and want only the best for them.

Isaiah is picturing God as the shepherd for his people in Israel. The New Testament presents Jesus as a sheep to his people. He called his disciples sheep and used sheep in illustrations to deliver messages. Jesus guided these men along and provided for all they needed. He carried them close to his heart and we must understand that he does the same for us today. Jesus does care about us. Jesus loves us. The lambs were the weakest and the neediest. The shepherd would provide for their needs. He would carry them wherever they needed to go. This shepherd willing gave his life for his sheep. As he now sits at the father's right hand, he wants only the best for his flock. What a wonderful savior that he is!
