Pergamum was the city which was the center of emperor worship. Everyone was required to pledge his allegiance to Caesar and to worship him. If a Christian refused to do this then the penalty was death. Antipas was a man placed in this predicament. He was a faithful witness for Jesus Christ. He refused to deny his Lord and worship a mere man. For this reason, men placed him in the image of a bronze bull and lit a fire under it. As the image got hotter and hotter it began to appear as if the bull was breathing and then the screams and moans of Antipas would make it seem as if the bull was doing the moaning. What a horrible method of death devised by Satan to make Christians think about their commitment.

While we are blessed with hardly any situations that cause death in the United States, there are still today places that may require your life if you confess Christ. Is your faith strong enough to remain firm to the end? Thankfully we understand the gift of eternal life through Jesus Christ. Antipas lost his physical life but gained eternal life. This required courage, commitment and determination as well as a deep faith. May we always pray that we will always be a faithful witness for our Lord.
