Psalm 147:1 Praise the Lord. How good it is to sing praises to our God, how pleasant and fitting to praise him!

One of the most recognized words around the world is Hallelujah. The last five Psalms start with Hallelujah. The word literally means praise Yah. Yah is the shortened name of God which is YHWH. Hallelujah in the Greek language is Alleluia. The simple translation is praise the Lord. How well do you praise the Lord? Our God is so good to us and so we sing praises to him.
