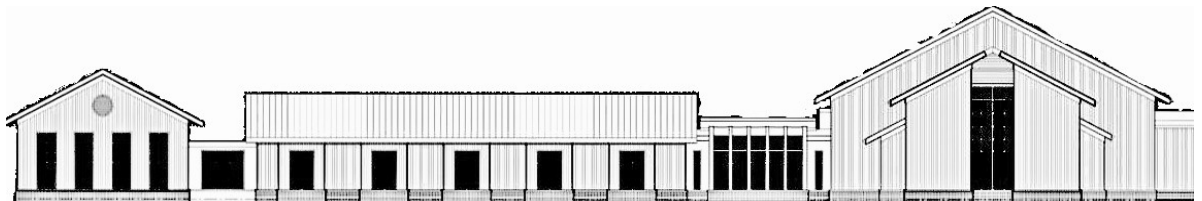

Psalm 91

91:1 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.
