The point is all of us have them to remove. The question is what is keeping you from doing so? There will be a lot of enthusiasm and excitement when we build our new building. It must be harnessed by each of us individually and translated into meaningful and lasting changes for Christ. So, how many rocks will you remove and what will be the results?
