However, buildings cannot make an impact upon the world for Christ! Only His people living the word daily can.

What role you play in all of this is up to you. The success and failure of this new endeavor for the cause of Christ will be determined in large part by your involvement or lack thereof. It is my prayer we all make the most of it.
