One of my favorite things about children is how they will confuse/ mispronounce things. This is especially true when they are young. This innocence thought often incorrect in the facts is offered up in the greatest of sincerity. One great example of this is in the following statements taken from an article called, "The Bible according to kids."

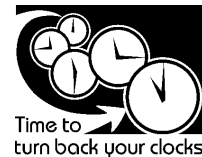
