# How I See It. By: Brian Gregory

I recently read the following article written by a faithful brother in Christ. It forces us to think about Jesus in a different light and frees us from some of our own ideas that have and will enslave us and cause us to be less effective in serving God. The whole idea is not about what Jesus "did" or "could do" but rather what He "cannot do".

Expectations have much to do with our contentment. Those who place unrealistic expectations upon themselves are generally discouraged, and feel as though they are a failure. I'm convinced that if people had proper expectations, they would not be so soon moved to discouragement, depression, and despair. An obvious step to "reeling in" our expectations is to understand the fact that "if Jesus couldn't do something, we need to stop believing we can. Consider:

- Jesus couldn't make his own family believe that he was the Son of God (John 7:1-6), so why then do we beat ourselves up for sometimes failing to do the same?
- Jesus couldn't avoid sadness and sorrow (<u>Isaiah 53:5</u>), so why do we sometimes act as though we expect life to be a bed of roses?
- Jesus couldn't go without rest (Mark 6:31), so why do we feel guilty if we aren't on the go 24/7?
- Jesus couldn't avoid making enemies (<u>John 15:18</u>), so why are we so surprised when people hate us for our faith?
- Jesus couldn't cause all men to repent (<u>Matthew 23:37</u>), so let's be content with our best efforts. We can't obey for others.
- Jesus couldn't even forgive all men of their sins though he was willing (<u>John 8:24</u>; <u>Luke</u> 17:3), so why do we think we can forgive those who will not repent?

Maybe the first step to contentment is in shedding the guilt that comes from the unrealistic expectations we place upon ourselves. After all, if Jesus couldn't do it, why do we think we can?

## **Summits of the Psalms**

By: Joe Macer Psalm107

107:8 Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men.

God is a deliverer. People rebel and they make mistakes. Sin, especially rebellion, brings about consequences. The Psalmist recalled from the history of Israel a few of the difficult situations they found themselves in due to their sins. He presented a pattern. People sinned, bad consequences resulted, the people cried out to God for help and due to his mercy and love the distress was removed. Here are some examples given by the Psalmist:

- 1. Some wandered in the desert hungry and thirsty. (4) 2. Some were prisoners and subjected to bitter labor.
- (10-12)
- 3. Some suffered afflictions, loathed food and were near death. (17-18)
- 4. Some were in peril on the seas. (22-27)
- 5. The nation was humbled by oppression, calamity and sorrow. (39)

In each case, the people cried out to the Lord for help. In each situation he delivered them from their distress. Why? It was not because they were worthy but because God was merciful and loving. Most of us can say God has delivered us from our sins and once again it is due to his mercy, grace and love. When we turn from our rebellion, God is so willing to help. We should respond with love and thanksgiving. Let's conclude with the final verse of this Psalm. "Whoever is wise, let him heed these things and consider the great love of the Lord."
