Over the past few weeks we have lost two of our members here at Eastside. First, we lost Bro. Robert Norman. A few weeks later we lost Sis. Betty Carol. Both of these people were faithful Christians when they died. However, their stories beforehand were very different.

Bro. Robert was 86 years old when he passed away. He finally succumbed to the complications from cancer. He spent several years of his childhood in a local orphanage. One night as a young boy around the age of 10-12 years old, he made the decision he was going to become a Christian. No sooner did he make his way to the front of the room, one of the head teacher's grabbed him by the collar and forced him back into his seat while stating, "Sit down you do not know what you are doing." In Roberts's case, he went on to serve his country as a Marine in WWII fighting in Iwo Jima, raised a family and worked hard to provide for them. It was finally at the age of 83, he took the opportunity to obey the gospel. I personally knew him to be a man of great faith even through all the physical pain he suffered.

Sis. Betty was also 86 years old when she passed away. Betty had been a Christian for many decades. She was very dedicated to the work of the church. Always wanting to serve others and active in doing so. She raised a family, retired as a R.N. She loved and helped many people along with her husband of 63 years, Bill. Most of all, she never wanted any credit or acknowledgement for what she did for others. How much good she did and all she did for others in the name of Christ only the Lord knows for certain and that is all that really matters.

Both of these stories are different, but they have the same ending. Although Betty was a faithful Christian for decades and Robert was only one for a few years, they both will receive the same reward. In Matthew 20:1-16, Jesus spoke a parable about workers in a vineyard. There were some who labored all day and some who laborer only at the last hour. In the end they all got paid the same amount. Jesus is telling us no matter how late in life you become a Christian, as long as your heart is right, your repentance is sincere, there is still a place for you in Heaven if you will obey Him. Although it is true there is a reward for those who come to Jesus later in life, there is no guarantee you will make it. It is very dangerous to put off obeying the gospel especially when you know what you need to do. How will the story of your life end? The decisions you are making about how you do or do not live now will greatly determine the answer to that question.


