This summer, eight people (two adults and six teens) from Eastside will serve along-side dozens of other people from Chapel Hill and Lewisburg on a short-term mission trip to the **City of Children** located on the Baja Peninsula in Ensenada, Mexico. This orphanage can house up to 150 Mexican children. It is a home that is sponsored by over 180 churches of Christ and private individuals from across the nation, as they receive no American or Mexican government funding. Throughout the year 20 groups from different congregations and schools visit the home for a week to help minister to the kids and show God's love to the children. You can take my word for it: this is no ordinary mission trip! The City of Children is a place very dear to my heart. In the past ten years I have visited the orphanage over 20 times and it is the place that God used to break my heart and open the door for me to become a youth minister. I know He can do the same thing to the hearts of our teens.

Each day, all day, we will work with the children at the orphanage and with local missionaries to spread the love of God throughout the orphanage and the city of Ensenada. Yes, we will sweat! We will work long and hard for an entire week! And we can't wait to do it! It will be an adventure and we know many blessings are ahead for us.

We are excited about giving our time and effort to this mission...but not all of us can handle the financial cost of this life-changing trip. At this time our teens are writing letters to family and friends for help with financial contributions. If you would like to sponsor one of our teens and help with some of their expenses please let me or one of the Elders know. Most importantly we ask for your prayers in the weeks and months to come. We are so thankful for a great church family that shares our heart for mission work.
