Summits of the Psalms By: Joe Macer Psalm 123

123:3 Have mercy on us, O Lord, have mercy on us, for we have endured much contempt.

When you find that persecution, contempt or ridicule is thrown your way, where do you go for help? The Psalmist made the decision to go to God. His eyes would look towards the throne of God in heaven itself. God is the one that can help. He has the power and the strength. He has the ability to destroy the works of man and bring about great results for his children. No matter what the trouble or the concerns may be, take your desires to God. Let him know your inner thoughts and desires.

The writer asked for mercy. His humility was showing through as he pleaded with God. He did not ask for vengeance. He did not seek retaliation. He was not moaning the fact that life is not fair. He simply wanted God's mercy and grace. He wanted God's guidance and protection. When trouble of any kind comes our way, it is fitting to ask God for his mercy.
