Over the weekend, I began building an entertainment center for my children's play room. After getting the thing almost completely assembled, I took it to the basement and began to paint it. While I was rolling out the paint, I noticed a fly buzzing around the paint tray. A few moments later, I saw it on its back stuck in the paint. I immediately thought to myself, this was the worst possible mistake that fly could have made.

Knowing as we all do, the fly had no way of knowing how dangerous the paint would be if it was caught in it. Also the fly never gave any thought to the consequences of its actions. Of course this is all because flies do not have the capacity to think like this. However, humans do and yet, too often we still think like flies. How many times do we fail to see the danger in something until it is too late or someone else tells us how lucky we were to not get injured? How often do we fail to think about the consequences of our actions before we do something? So many people, even members of the Lord's church, fall prey to sin in the same ways. We think nothing will happen to us, or we will be the exception. We think it will not hurt anything just this once, etc. . . We fail to see the consequences, a life separated from God (Isa. 59:1-2) and death (Rm. 6:23) spiritual definitely and sometimes even physical. Many fail to heed the warnings from those who love us and most of all from God. Sometimes we even think there will be plenty of time to escape or live right later, but cemeteries are full of people who thought the same things at one time and realized how wrong they were. Why not take God seriously and think more like Christians and less like flies. See and admit the danger of sin and avoid it. The writer of Hebrews asked a very pointed and relevant question, "How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation (Heb. 2:3)? The answer is we cannot and will not, if we neglect it. Instead we will one day find we have made the worst possible mistake.
