How I See It By: Brian Gregory

Over the past few months I have had several car repair jobs to do. I have replaced the front and rear brakes on my wife's van, changed the oil in both of our vehicles, replaced the rear struts in my car and had the belts replaced. Over the past few weeks I have (as you can imagine) made several trips to the auto parts store. I have actually frequented one store so often most of the employees recognize me and know me by name. This is great for customer service and loyalty by the way. I have almost exclusively made these trips on Saturdays while I was ready to or in the middle of working on one of my vehicles. I am usually wearing a dirty or soon to be dirty shirt and a pair of old shoes and shorts, you know work clothes. However, despite my appearance I am always mindful of what I say and how I say in public especially. I want to try to have as much personal influence for Christ as possible.

After completing some of this work this past weekend, I had to borrow a special tool to complete the job which I could return for a full refund at a later date. On Sunday after church I went to this same place to return these items. There were two of the employees I have become familiar/ friends with working that morning. To their surprise they did not recognize me at first because I much cleaner and dressed nicer. We all had a good laugh and then I revealed who I am and what I do for a living. At the appropriate time I told them about our new church building, and some of the future plans and invited them to our "Grand Opening" as I like to call it. One man said he would like to come. I do not know if he will or not but at least he has been invited.

What is all of this about? No it is not an opportunity to toot my own horn or self promote. I told this story to illustrate a few points. First, we can never a proper judgment about what someone is or is not like based upon what they are wearing alone. My looks were obviously deceiving. Second, no matter how we are dressed (aside from immodest and inappropriate) we always need to remember we wear the name of Christ first and foremost. Third, when you take the time to get to know people a little you will have a better chance at approaching them with the gospel. This does not mean cramming it down their throats or having a Bible study with them. But, it does mean we can invite them and offer an opportunity for them to hear the gospel. Fourth, take advantage of the opportunity you have. You may never get another one. It is not up to you or anyone else to covert people, but it is up to each of us to give people an opportunity to hear the gospel. How well you represent Christ to the world will determine our success.

Summits of the Psalms By: Joe Macer Psalm 140

140:4 Keep me, O Lord, from the hands of the wicked;

protect me from men of violence who plan to trip my feet.

If David is the writer of this Psalm, then he knew exactly how it felt to be attacked by evil men. He ran from Saul for years. He fled from his own son. The nations surrounding Israel often attacked them. The Psalmist asked God for his protection. As Christians, we live in an evil world and we must expect opposition from the wicked. We survive and thrive in such situation by fully trusting in the Lord. This was exactly what David did.

What were the specifics of the writer's prayer? He asked for mercy and he pleaded for deliverance. He asked for God's shield of protection when the day of battle came. Finally, he prayed that the plans of the wicked would not succeed. In the midst of this prayer he openly confesses his faith in God by saying, "You are my God."

The wicked never learn that their evil will come back upon them. The writer asked that their heads be covered with the trouble that they had caused. He asked that burning coals would fall upon them and that the wicked would fall into their miry pits. Finally, he asked that disaster would find these men of violence. This is a tremendous contrast with the righteous. The upright will live and they will praise the name of the Lord. If today you find enemies trying to make your life miserable, then ask God for his protection, guidance and mercy. Trust in him.
