During the War Between the States, a young woman learned the truth and obeyed the gospel. Her sweetheart, J.H. Halbrook was a confederate soldier. He was captured by the Union army and kept prisoner in Michigan until the war was over. He was given a ticket to Nashville and \$2.50. From there he returned to Centerville, TN and found what was left of his home and family. He found his girlfriend and they soon married. His wife studied with him and he soon became a Christian. He thought the truth was so good and simple, that he began to teach and baptize many. Seeing the need for further training, he came to the original Mars Hill bible School in Florence AL. Instead of return to TN, he want further south into AL. One of his converts was C.A. Wheeler whose wife taught him to read from the Bible. Bro. Wheeler soon began preaching in South AL and started more than 100 congregations and baptized more than 6,000 people.

One of those people was Gus Nichols who baptized more than 12,000 people. Among those baptized by Bro. Nichols, no one knows, nor can know, how many began to preach the gospel but there are several. One of his sons Flavil Nichols was one and has baptized about 3,000 people. A few of them preach also.

Only eternity can reveal the total results of that one conversion over 150 years ago. The results are not yet all in. But thus far it shows that 21,000 people have become Christians through the single thread in the fabric of her influence. Go and do likewise (Lk. 10:37). You are important too. If you go to heaven, others probably will be saved by you and your influence.

We never know what affect and impact we will personally have for Christ upon others. Never underestimate your importance to the Kingdom and to others. What will eternity have to say about the impact of your life upon the Kingdom of God? Whether it is good or bad depends upon you alone.


