An elderly couple of my acquaintance no longer is able to keep house for themselves. They share a small room in a nursing home. Over the years they attended church faithfully. Now she is bedfast, and his health is failing rapidly. I have visited with them often, conversing only with him. She is now comatose.

Today, I was asking him if he would like for me to come by for him tomorrow for church. Before he could answer we were surprised by her voice, "I'll go! I'll go!" The boundary of the comatose could not prevent the excitement of the shut in when she thought about going to church. Only four words, but what an eloquent sermon, and what a rebuke!

Multitudes have enough religion to know what church they are staying away from, yet here was an invalid who would give anything if she could only get out of bed, dress herself, and go to church just one more time. "Dear God forgive me for thinking that church attendance is a burden. There are many who would jump at the chance to take my place."

That is true not only of many on the beds of affliction, but also of millions who are prevented by law or decree from worshipping the God of Creation. Sometimes we don't know how well off we are.

The Psalmist wrote: "I was glad when they said unto me, let us go into the house of the Lord." (Psalm 122:1). The writer of the book of Hebrews urges us to not forsake the assembling of ourselves together for in the assembly we receive encouragement. (Hebrews 10:24-25).

Isn't it amazing how we can take a thing for granted? Many think that there will always be time later to attend to spiritual matters. But often there is not. How do you suppose the lady in the nursing home came to value the worship so highly? I don't believe that it was after she went to the nursing home or after she became comatose. She valued it all along. It was precious to her. But all too often we who are able bodied and really without excuse find ourselves absent from the worship assembly. Where will you be this Sunday? "Lay up treasure in heaven, for where your treasure is there will your heart he also."

Summits of the Psalms By: Joe Macer Psalm 53

53:3 Everyone has turned away, they have together become corrupt; there is no one who does good, not even one.

Sin is common to man. There comes a point in our lives in which we turn away from God's word and seek our own way. We fail to seek him. The writer described people as corrupt, having vile ways, not doing good, turning away from God and classified as evildoers. Paul used these same thoughts in describing men in the book of Romans. Truly, we fall far short of the glory of God and the plan that he has for us. Some go so far as to say there is no God. They want to be the master of their own lives and if they admit to the existence of God then they cannot do as they wish. Others may believe in God and yet never call upon him for help. Once again they want to believe that they are in control and soon enough life will show them they are not. Man in his weakness will always fail God. Men need a savior.

The Psalmist cried out, "Oh, that salvation for Israel would come out of Zion!" Do you realize this is exactly what happened? Jesus Christ is the one who provided salvation. Where did he do this? He was crucified, died and arose again to life in Jerusalem. Zion and Jerusalem are synonyms. All men sin and Jesus died that we might be forgiven of our sins and be in a right relationship with God. When salvation comes, then the people will rejoice. Are you rejoicing this day due to what Jesus has done? Have you accepted his free gift of salvation? When God looks down from heaven, does he see you seeking him? Let's make up our mind to serve him and to thank him for his precious gift of eternal life.
