Summits of the Psalms By: Joe Macer Psalm 52

52:1 Why do you boast of evil, you mighty man? Why do you boast all day long, you who are a disgrace in the eyes of God?

Have you ever looked an evil man in the eye? When meeting him face to face, what emotions run through your mind? There are some mean, evil people in this world. They seek to harm and destroy. No concern is shown for the one they try to dominate and control. The Psalmist described him as loving evil, plotting destruction with a tongue like a razor and speaking falsehoods. Tradition handed down ascribed this Psalm to David when he met Doeg at Nob. Doeg told Saul that he had seen David with the priest Ahimelech. Saul had 85 priests slain as well as other men, women and children in Nob.

David saw this man, knew of his evil deeds and yet believed that God was in control. He understood that God would bring him down to everlasting ruin. The evil man would be snatched from his tent and uprooted from the land of the living. The writer stood before God with confidence. It was much better to be in his shoes than in the shoes of the evil man. The evil man may bring us harm but the righteous man has made God his stronghold and he should never cower before or be ashamed due to the wicked man's threats or actions. God brings about justice.

The writer confessed his trust in God and his desire to praise God. He compared himself to an olive tree flourishing in the house of God. Did you know that an olive tree can live for hundreds of years? He intended to praise God forever. May we all strive to have a right relationship with God. Such good things await those who love the Lord but the evil man will come to ruin and eternal destruction.
