Summits of the Psalms

Psalm 60

60:1 You have rejected us, O God, and burst forth upon us; you have been angry – now restore us!

In many of the Psalms, the writer declared his or the nation's innocence. Bad things were happening but they were undeserved. In this Psalm, the nation had been wrong.
