How I See It. By: Brian Gregory

When you think about religious people what comes to mind? Do you think about someone who goes to church often or someone who acts a certain way? Do you think about someone who can quote scripture or someone who does good deeds? There are several things that come to mind when we think about being religious. However, these do not always indicate ones proper allegiance to God. Consider the following?

Before beginning His personal ministry, Jesus spent 40 days alone in the wilderness (Mt. 4). During this time He was tempted by Satan. As Satan tried his best to get Jesus to sin, he did several surprising things. **First,** he quoted scripture. Every time he tempted Jesus, Jesus responded by quoting scripture (Mt. 4:4,7,10). But Satan also used scripture (Mt. 4:6; Ps. 91:11-12). Thus even Satan recognized the power of scripture (Heb. 4:12). In this Satan also perverted scripture. His quotation from Psalm 91, was mostly correct. However, he greatly misapplied its meaning. The passage teaches about God's providential care, not His miraculous intervention when people recklessly put Him to the test and challenge His power. Many people still misapply and pervert scriptures today. **Second,** Satan recognized the power and position of Jesus. Although he was trying to get Jesus to deny it and/or prove it in an unnecessary fashion, Satan knew Jesus was the Son of God and possessed miraculous powers (Mt. 4:3). Just acknowledging this does not make one a Christian or religious (Mt. 7:21-23). **Third,** Satan took Jesus to a place of place of worship (Mt. 4:5). Satan was present at the highest point of the temple where God's people worshipped. This did not make Satan one of God's people.

As we look at other passages of scripture we also learn, the following things about Satan. When the sons of God convene, he is present (Job. 1:6). He has a synagogue (Rev. 3:9). He has ministers (2 Cor. 11:14, 15). He can transform himself into an angel of light (2 Cor. 11:14). To sum it all up, Satan does a lot of things we would easily attribute to a religious person. Yet, we must ask ourselves the question, "Am I a as religious as the devil?"

Summits of the Psalms

By: Joe Macer Psalm 82

82:1 God presides in the great assembly; he gives judgment among the "gods":

God is the King of all kings, the Lord of all lords and the master of all. He is the Creator and the giver of life. Among men we find various ranks and honors but all men are subject to God. Gods with a little g found in the first verse refers to human rulers. Some rulers of men have been known to take their power and control to the point that they call themselves a god. No matter how important that they see themselves they are still accountable to God and he will judge them. God will be the presider on judgment day.

Being a ruler carries certain obligations with it. Think about various rulers from the local government up to the president of this nation or the king of another nation. Are they fulfilling their responsibilities? Here are some concepts to think about from the Psalmist. Are you a just person or do you defend the unjust and show partiality to the wicked? Do you take a stand for the weak and the fatherless? Do you maintain the rights of the poor and the oppressed? Do you rescue the weak and the needy? Do you deliver people from the hand of the wicked? God knows and all rulers will answer for their actions. When we have the ability to vote we need to consider such questions about those we elect. Rulers must never forget that they also are but mere men. All men will die and after that, face judgment. The Psalmist concludes by asking God to judge the earth. In so doing wicked rulers would be remove and righteous one remain and the world will be a better place. As the New Testament teaches, will you not pray for your rulers? Pray that they will be men of justice seeking after God. If they will do this the world will be a better place.
