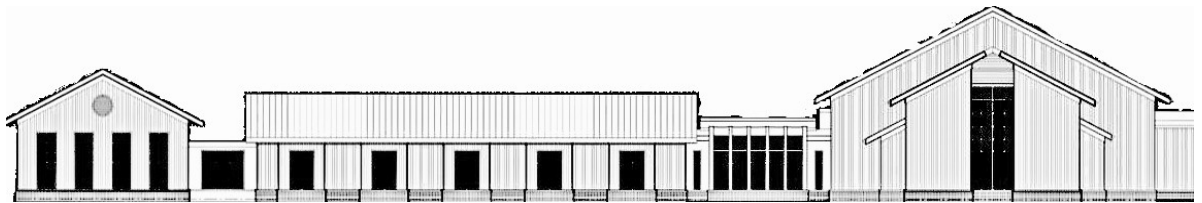

## Summits of the Psalms

### Psalm 90

90:12 Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.

This Psalm is a prayer of Moses. He begins by acknowledging the greatness of God and the eternity of God. This is contrasted with the short life of men. Moses declared that a man might live 70 or possibly 80 years and this short lifetime would be full of trouble and sorrow. At the conclusion of our life we die and then return to dust. There are two possible timeframes of the writing of this Psalm. Some believe this prayer was uttered at the conclusion of the forty years in Midian. Others believe this was written during the forty years of wandering. Whichever time of this writing, Moses had seen troubling days. He was asking for relief. He wanted joy once again and wanted to sing of it. Satisfaction was desired from the presence of God's love. He asked for the number of good days to be the same as the number of days of affliction. Both situations described above were forty years.

How do we find enjoyment once again? The request from Moses to God is important for us to understand and to ask of God as well. Moses prayed, "Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain a heart of wisdom." Always pray that God will teach us the best way and lessons from our triumphs as well as our failures. Pray that we will have the proper priorities in our lives each and every day. Our time on earth is precious but it is to be devoted to the cause of God. Finally, pray that our hearts and minds will guide us with wisdom. If this prayer is answered favorably then we will find the favor of God in our lives and the works of our hands will be established.
