### The Apple of Your Eye

Proverbs 7:2 Keep my commands and you will live; guard my teachings as the apple of your

The phrase "apple of your eye" is an old expression that originally referred to the pupil of the eye. Since our eyesight is so valuable, the pupil is protected by the eyelid. Every person would go to great lengths in order to save their eyesight. In later history, the phrase has come to mean the one that is most important in your sight. Each explanation conveys the concept of importance and value. Do we believe God's word to be important to us as well as valuable? In the previous verse, Solomon instructed his son to store up God's commands within you. Now he gives the reason why keep my commands and you will live.
