## One Verse At A Time By: Joe Macer

#### **And Do Not Grumble**

I Corinthians 10:10 "And do not grumble, as some of them did - and were killed by the destroying angel."

When a word dealing with our actions is associated with death, we ought to pay close attention to it. What does the word grumble mean? The definition is to mutter in discontent. The words that come to my mind are moan, groan and bellyache. A few other synonyms are fuss, gripe, whine and to find fault. We are all guilty of this from time to time. Let's consider what is being taught by this verse.

From context of this passage, we are to consider how God reacted to various situations dealing with the Israelites. By studying their conduct and God's reactions, we can spare ourselves of many troubles. God's people should learn from the mistakes of previous generations. What caused the destroying angel to appear to the Israelites? Three men - Korah, Dathan and Abiram (Numbers 16) - rose up against Moses and Aaron and denounced the authority given to them by the Lord. The Lord punished them by swallowing these men up in the ground along with their households, possessions and followers. God spoke clearly that he was with Moses and Aaron. How did Israel respond? Did that silence them? No. Did they admit that Korah and his followers were wrong? No. Instead the whole community grumbled against Moses and Aaron and claimed they had killed the Lord's people. God did send the destroying angel and 14,700 Israelites died before the plague Grumbling is serious business especially when it is against God's chosen leadership. Earlier in Numbers 14 grumbling was part of the reason the Israelites wandered in the wilderness for forty years. Grumbling against God and his authority is serious business. We had best pay close attention to the recorded Scriptures in this matter.
