A friend of mind recently posted these thoughts on her face book page.

If a guy walks up to you, looks you up and down then precedes to ask you to marry him? Would you? No... you would feel cheap. He doesn't even know me ... why would I take that step with a stranger? If a stranger walks up to you and invites you to church .. will you go? No... you don't even know them. Makes you feel cheap right? Do they want just another person in the pew? As a Christian, I am beginning to see God called us to make disciples but it is much deeper than that. He wants us to love the people, get to know them because we actually care about them, not because we have our own agenda or something to prove. That is how you get people to follow you into His kingdom.

As a Christian, do you really care? Do you really love you neighbor? Your cashier? Your waitress? No... you don't even know them. Get to know them! Those whom you do love... you love because you know who they are, what they believe...what makes them who they are. The answer is and always will be LOVE. The question is.... how to teach Christians to care enough to truly love?

I personally believe these thoughts are right on target with our calling in God's Kingdom. To love others we have to get to know them. There is a certain level of love we can feel for all mankind because of our basic humanity. However, the love Jesus said would define His disciples to the world (Jn. 13:34-35) requires me to know Jesus and take the time to know others. Just because it is rare a stranger will come to church because we invited them does not mean we should never do so. It does mean we should take the time to invest a little in knowing them first before we ask. We can never love others nor will others see our love (and by extension God's love) until we get to know them. Look at Jesus' example throughout the gospels. He was willing to spend time with those who were broken, hurting, downcast and outcast. From the ones no one else wanted to those who everyone loved and respected (See John 3 and 4) to everyone in between, Jesus was a people person who made following and serving God about showing love to others and never just about what we do inside a building. So, I ask, How are you loving others? How are you showing God's love to others?
