Jude 22-23

Be merciful to those who doubt; snatch others from the fire and save them; to others show mercy, mixed with fear - hating even the clothing stained by corrupted flesh.

A few weeks ago I happened upon a farm vehicle that had just overturned in the middle of the highway. I was one of the first on the scene and by chance coming from the other direction was an ambulance. The man was inside of the cab and his truck was leaking fuel badly. The ambulance worker stated she was not going near that truck with all the fuel pouring out of it. I got close and saw he was not hurt but was very slow about getting out.
