Romans 1:32 Although they know God's righteous decree that those who do such things deserve death, they not only continue to do these very things but also approve of those who practice them.

Do you know what behavior that God expects of people and is this what you strive to do? A few sentences before today's verse, Paul records a few sins such as: wickedness, evil, greed, depravity, envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice, gossip as well as others. Paul has two accusations in this verse to make towards mankind. First, many individuals know what God's laws are and they refuse to do them. They understand the behavior is wrong and that the end result will be death. Due to a lack of faith, hatred towards God or succumbing to temptation these individuals are guilty of this behavior and without forgiveness will reap the consequences. Each of us should educate ourselves thoroughly in order to know what God wants and then strive to do as he has commanded.

The second accusation is that individuals would give approval for others to do this wrong behavior. Countless times I have heard individuals say (especially politicians) that I would never do that but if someone else wants to do it then who am I to say they can't?
