#### The Lamb's Book of Life. . . By Joe Macer

Revelation 21:27 Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

The twenty-first chapter of Revelation recorded many facts and statements about the heavenly city. This Holy City is where the Lord God Almighty resides as well as the Lamb. This is the location that has no death, mourning, crying or pain. Earlier the chapter informs us that those who are cowardly, unbelieving, vile, murderers, sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars will not be allowed to inherit this wonderful city. Today's passage also declares that nothing impure will ever enter this city. This verse does tell us who can inherit this city though - those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life. How do we get our name in that book?

Scriptures mention this book on a few occasions. We learn in Revelation 20:15 that anyone whose name was not found in the book of life would be thrown into the lake Writing to the members of the church at Sardis the Lord promised to never blot out the name of the individuals from the book of life who overcomes the evils of this world. From these verses, it is obvious that the righteous have their name in the book of life whereas the unrighteous do not have their name in this book and due to this will be lost in hell. Our name is placed in this book when through our faith we obey the commands of the Lord for salvation. Have you obeyed the process of becoming a Christian and has your life been dedicated to the service of Jesus? There is no more important decision to be made than to accept the gift of salvation provided by Jesus Christ. Is your name written there?
