The identity of Gaius is not thoroughly known. He could possibly be the same individual as in I Corinthians 1:14 as it is believed that Paul wrote to the Romans from Corinth. When Paul thought of this man, he remembered his hospitality. The church at Rome met in homes. It is quite possible that Gaius had opened his home for worship. He had definitely shared his home with Paul the traveling minister. Paul was on the move constantly as he preached the gospel.
