## **An Outstanding Manager.... *By Joe Macer***

**Luke 12:43** It will be good for that servant whom the master finds doing so when he returns.

Imagine that you own a company with many employees working for you. How easy is it to find a trusted employee? Out of all the employees, how many would you completely trust to do exactly what you want while you are gone on an extended trip? Jesus wanted to drive home a point about faithfulness. A master was about to leave on a trip and he would put a servant in charge of feeding the other servants. Certainly he would choose someone that he considered faithful and wise. He would expect this person to do exactly as instructed. Once the master is gone the servant has two choices - either he can do exactly as instructed or he can decided to do things his own way. In the Lord's account, authority apparently went to the servant's head and he began beat his fellow servants and began to get drunk. What will the master say and do when he returns to find the unfaithful servant? The servant is deserving of punishment and he will receive it.

What should we learn from this account? The Lord has left for a while but he will return. He has been gone for a long time but this does not negate the fact that he will return and it will be unexpectedly. Christians are servants of the Lord. He has left us in charge of his work to do his will while he is away. He expects faithfulness. The question raised by the Lord's illustration is this - Am I faithfully fulfilling the Lord's will? When he returns, will he be pleased or saddened by what he finds? May it ever be our intentions to do exactly as he has instructed us. Let's be faithful to the Lord in his work.
