The Lamb of God

John 1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world!

Jesus is represented by many titles in chapter one of John. In this verse, he is referred to as the Lamb of God. Also in this chapter is called, Rabbi, Messiah, Christ, Son of God, King of Israel, Son of Man and Jesus of Nazareth. Each of these titles is presenting a picture in the mind of those listening to John. Specifically what does the phrase Lamb of God mean to those hearing John?

Many ideas would come to the mind of the Jewish people. Perhaps the image was Abraham taking Isaac to sacrifice him. Isaac was spared and a ram was provided in his place. Perhaps the image was the lamb that was eaten at the Passover to remind the Israelites of their days in Egypt. More than likely the Jewish worshippers were thinking of the lambs that were sacrificed at the temple as a substitution for their sins. A final possibility is the lamb led to the slaughter found in Isaiah 53. In each of the instances the lamb was a sacrifice. Jesus Christ came to be our sacrifice. No doubt those in the audience understood this about Jesus.

What was the reason for the coming of the Lamb of God? John said that he came to "take away the sin of the world!" Jesus' sacrifice on the cross of Calvary had a very important reason. His death on the cross was to pay the price for the sins of people. The forgiveness is there for those who will express their faith in Jesus and submit to baptism. This hope is for the whole world. From a remote island in the South Seas to the most populated city in China, the gift of forgiveness is available. If you have not accepted this precious gift will you not do so today?

Money Matters

Luke 3:10b-14 ... "Then what shall we do?" 11 And he would answer and say to them, "The man who has two tunics is to share with him who has none: and he who has food is to do likewise." 12 And some tax collectors also came to be baptized, and they said to him, "Teacher, what shall we do?" 13 And he said to them, "Collect no more than what you have been ordered to." 14 Some soldiers were questioning him, saying, "And what about us, what shall we do?" And he said to them, "Do not take money from anyone by force, or accuse *anyone* falsely, and be content with your wages."

In Luke 3 John the Baptizer is answering the crowd's question of what shall we do to repent. I find it interesting that with all of the things he could tell them to turn from, most of his answers dealt with their approach to money. Share with the poor, don't take more from others than is fair, don't take money by force and be content with your wages were John's commands for those who wanted to follow God's will. He communicated a deep connection between how they dealt with money in their lives and their relationship with God. This Sunday we will look at the family's approach to finances and how our financial decisions can help us to glorify God. See you Sunday!
