The access code for the South Gate Bible Bowl is TB23F-NWF75. Once you have put in the access code you will be a part of our class. The questions are in the form of multiple choice quizzes over each chapter. To take a quiz go to materials and click on I Thessalonians quiz and you will be asked the questions over chapter one. At the end of the quiz it will show you all of the correct answers. You can take the quizzes as many times as you want. Family Provisions

I Timothy 5:8 If anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for his immediate family, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

As Paul writes to Timothy, he instructs Timothy to make sure the widows in need are provided for. The church has the responsibility to meet the needs of widows who are left all alone. Who does the responsibility belong to first? It belongs to her family. If she has children or grandchildren, they must take care of her daily needs. The church is not to be burdened if family is there to provide. Children or grandchildren are to repay for what has been done for them in previous years. Mothers give their all to take care of their children. Their dedication and sacrifice deserves repayment. Christians should not neglect this duty. Are there Christians that ignore their parent's needs? Are there Christians that do not even communicate with their parents or see if there is a need? Sadly, the answer is yes.

What is the standing of a Christian that does not provide for the mother who is widowed? First, he had denied the faith. Faith is used in the sense of doctrine here. The individual is negligent of not following the doctrine of Christ. Secondly, the individual is worse than an unbeliever. The whole world understands that children should take care of their parents. All nations and all societies naturally know to do this. Christianity is a religion of love. Where is the love if a person does not provide for their own? Christianity is to set the example for all to see. Failure in this matter sets an extremely poor example.
