So here's the question: Are you a person of faith or not? Yeah, I know you answered "faith" – but as Lee Corso says, "no so fast my friend." Yep, it's the right answer. It's also the easy answer. If we're not careful we give the "right" answer even if it's not the true or thought through answer.

Let me ask it a little differently: Are you really a person of faith? Faith is a verb. It is seen in our actions. What are you doing right now, or attempting to do that you would not be attempting without faith in your life? If the answer is "nothing" then I question if you really have faith. If all you do is what you can "see your way to do" then it is not faith. Elders, preachers and leaders who say: "I think I can see how we can do that", are stopping short of God's desire.

If you can do it by your own strength and power and might and mind and ability what do you need God for. But if when you finish it other see you could not have done it without His power then maybe you learned what He tried to teach Gideon (Jud. 7:1-23). What Jehovah said to Zerubbabel: "'Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the LORD Almighty" (Zec. 4:6). He wanted Paul to know: "He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness." Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me. Therefore I am well content with weaknesses, with insults, with distresses, with persecutions, with difficulties, for Christ's sake; for when I am weak, then I am strong (2 Cor. 12:9-10).

See if you do it by your own might when you finish people think you are good but if it is for God and through Him then when it is done people will glorify God – not you.

What are you attempting to do for the Lord that you would not and could not unless it was by faith?

I Timothy 1:16 "But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his unlimited patience as an example for those who would believe on him and receive eternal life."
