Are Your Insides Clean?

Luke 11:39 Then the Lord said to him, "Now then, you Pharisees clean the outside of the cup and dish, but inside you are full of greed and wickedness.

After eating a bowl of soup, then it is time to wash the bowl. How often would someone only wash the outside of the bowl? Would we not always wash both the inside and the outside of the bowl? Jesus is condemning some Pharisees who are doing this very thing with their lives. They made sure that the outside of their bodies were clean and they were right to do so.
