Use A Little Wine

I Timothy 5:23 "Stop drinking only water, and use a little wine because of your stomach and your frequent illnesses"

As I ate breakfast one morning last week, a television news reporter was given a few dollars to go shopping for supplies for a Super Bowl party. What was the first stop for the shopper? It was the beer and whiskey aisle. This had to be the first purchase and then if any money was left over they would get chips. We live in an alcohol saturated society but it is not all that different from most of human history. All Christians would agree that drunkenness is a sin but what about an occasional drink now and then? This verse is used by individuals to allow people to drink a beer or glass of wine now and then. I believe the full impact of the verse is missed when used this way. Timothy was sick and he had stomach trouble but he was refusing to drink wine. Why? He was concerned about his Christian influence. Those he was trying to influence to leave the world behind would not be able to question Paul's response to him was that him about his habits. he could use alcohol for a medicinal purpose.

Often I am asked about times and places that do not have the quality of water that we have. People state that the water was unhealthy and forced the necessity of drinking wine. Was it possible to live without drinking wine? The answer is yes. In Jeremiah 35, the Recabites had gone 200-250 years without drinking wine. Their forefather Jonadab had charged his descendants to not drink wine and they obeyed his command. It was possible to avoid the use of alcohol. Can a meal be enjoyed without alcohol? Can a football game be fun without alcohol? The answer is yes. As Christians, let's be mindful of our influence for godly principles.
