2014 Theme "GOD's F.A.M.I.L.Y." Acts 2:37-47

How I See It. By: Brian Gregory

In 1 Kings 22, we have recorded a conversation between Judah's king—Jehoshaphat and Israel's king—Ahab. King Ahab is planning a war against Ramoth Gilead. He is urged by Jehoshaphat to seek the counsel of God before he goes. Ahab produces 400 pseudo-prophets and immediately Jehoshaphat recognizes these men as "yes men," So Jehoshaphat asks Ahab, "Is there not a prophet of the Lord here whom we can inquire of? How did Ahab respond?

There is still one man through whom we can inquire of the Lord, but I hate him because he never prophesies anything good about me, but always bad. He is Micaiah son of Imiah (1 Kings 22:8).

Ahab hated Micaiah because he told him the truth. In 2014, we are not much better as we respond to people who tell us things we don't want to hear. . . even when they are true. Even the apostle Paul asked the question to the church at Galatia, "Have I become your enemy because I tell you the truth? (Gal. 4:16).

There is no truth greater to know and obey than the Word of God. The question is do you hate it when you learn you have not been doing what He said? Do you hate it when you find your ways are wrong and need correction? Do you hate it when you learn you need to stop spending your way into more debt and start living within your means so you can give more to the Lord's work? Do you hate it when you learn God most desires your humble submission and love, instead of bragging about yourself and promoting yourself? Do you hate it when you learn you have to die to self and take up your cross daily to follow Him? Do you hate it when you see the world around you falling further away from God and needing some guidance or do you decide it is not your place to say anything?

No one likes to hear or know they have been wrong but how we respond to it when God is the one that points it out makes all the difference.
