Money is always an interesting subject and thing. It has been said, "Money cannot buy you happiness." However, life is a lot easier when you have more of it. To some people it means very little and others it means a lot. It is something no one is very likely to ever turn down if it is given or they happen upon it. Money itself is morally neutral (i.e., neither good nor bad). However, what we do with money and our attitudes toward it can be good or bad. It is interesting while many wealthy people give a combined total of billions of dollars annually, those who usually give the most as a percentage of their income are those who are in the lowest income brackets. I have seen those who can give big and give more do the least because of their attitude toward money. A little known fact about the ministry of Jesus is that He said more about money/possessions/wealth, than any other subject. This subject is fresh on my mind because I opened a savings account for each of my children this week. Finally instead of the bank of mom and dad, they now have their own personal savings accounts. With this in mind I wanted to share a few thoughts about money.

First, I believe our relationship toward money starts early. I recall being given a quarter each Sunday by a man at church and how excited I was to have it. I was told to save it or encouraged to give it to God at church. On one occasion I backed out and sat on my hands. Later I showed my money to my grandmother and she immediately shamed me for not giving like I should have. Needless to say I never let her know if I failed to give again. Our children learn in the home how we view money. Are there constant fights about it and how to spend it? Do you talk to them about how to use money and help them make decisions? Do you make it known giving to help others is important? Do you misuse your money on spending sprees and needless debt or are you greedy and tight with it? Your kids and grandkids will pick up on these things.

Second, money is not everything. Yes, I know this is hard to accept and learn. Money has a lot of potential power for good and evil. Even if we are not doing evil things with it our attitudes toward money can consume us and cause us to lose sight of what is most important in life. Notice, money will not make you live longer, get you into Heaven, make up for time lost with your loved ones, erase the past or guarantee the future. Even though the world around us says more, more, more, just because you have money to spend doesn't mean you have to. Jesus said, take heed and beware of greediness, for not even when one has an abundance does his life consist of his possessions (Lk. 12:15). In the end what matters most is not how rich we are in this world but how rich we are toward God

Practice What You Preach

Matthew 23:3 "So you must obey them and do everything they tell you. But do not do what they do, for they do not practice what they preach."

Jesus declared to the Jewish people that the teachers of the law and those that sat on Moses' seat were saying the right things and they should be obeyed. However when it came to their actions and what they were seen doing, it did not match their teachings. The leaders did not practice what they preached. Paul took up the same subject in Romans 2. He asked, "You preach against stealing, do you steal? You who say do not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples?" The point once again was to practice what you preach. James continues with the same thought when he said, "Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says."

This verse was not so much as about preachers as about leaders. Preachers certainly must try to the best of their ability to practice what they preach. One reason we do preach is to improve ourselves. Political leaders should practice what they preach. Employers should practice what they ask of their employees. Mothers and fathers should practice what they preach. Elders, song leaders, Bible class teachers should all practice what they preach. What is the result when the practice does not follow the preaching? There can be a loss of respect for the teacher. There also can be a loss of respect for the message or the messenger. If the leader does not do it, then can it be all that important? We all have influence with far more people than we realize. Let's set the proper example. If we are going to preach, lead, give advice or give demands in a family then let's do what we say. Let's let people see a sermon as well as hear one.
