Over the past few years with the passage of the Affordable Care Act (a.k.a. Obamacare), healthcare and insurance coverage have been hot and important topics. When you think about insurance coverage it is such a necessity in life. We have (or at least should) home owners, renters, car, boat and life insurance. Without proper coverage people have found themselves in desperate situations that have led to financial and even physical ruin. I think we all can agree it is so important to have insurance. Although it is smart to be insured, have you ever thought about the fact the things we insure are only temporary at best? What about insuring something that will last for eternity (i.e., our souls)? This led me to consider, since God is the only one who can and does truly offer something that lasts, what if He were an insurance salesman? What kind of plan would He offer? I think it would look something like this.

- God takes preexisting conditions (Jer. 8, Isa. 6). Regardless of past illness or injury no one is turned down for coverage.
- No referral is necessary. He can be seen at any time and always eagerly awaiting our visits and even available nights and weekends. In addition there is no extra cost for emergency visits (Phi. 4:6-8; 1 Pt. 5:6-7).
- He takes new patients. No waiting period necessary. His caseload/patient load is never too full. He can accommodate everyone (Jn. 3:16).
- No deductible to be met. No max out of pocket to be required before plan will pick up cost. All cost and deductible have been met by Christ's death (1 Jn. 2:2).
- No physical or paperwork required to qualify. It is offered freely and equally to all (Rm. 6:23, Eph 2:8-10).
- Premium is high but reasonable. Must deny yourself and take up cross daily (Mk.8:34-38).
- Death benefit included, but payable only upon faithfully meeting conditions set forth (Rev 2:10, 21).

What a plan! Why would you delay or deny yourself this coverage? Are you insured?

The Consequences of Sin

Jeremiah 16:1-2 Then the word of the Lord came to me: "You must not marry and have sons or daughters in this place."

Jeremiah was a man chosen to be a prophet for God. He spoke of the sins of Israel and Judah. Known as the weeping prophet, he had various situations that brought sadness into his life. Our verse today certainly added to that sadness. God demands that Jeremiah not have a wife or children. This was indeed painful to Jeremiah but as always there are excellent reasons for what God requires of us. If Jeremiah would have married and had children, he would have suffered even greater pain. Life without a spouse or children is hard to imagine. Seeing your children grow up and provide you with grandchildren is joy beyond expression. Parents and grandparents deeply involved with the little ones share in whatever pain that comes into their life. Knowing what was to come, God's command is saving Jeremiah from a world of hurt.

What was to come? God knew that the consequences for his people's departure from him would be severe. Israelites would see disease and death. How tragic to see little ones die. How painful when you are the parent. They would die from disease, famine and sword. How Jeremiah's heart would break to see his children die from a lack of food. How senseless would be the death of his children by invaders. It would be beyond understanding. Jeremiah was told to have no children due to these circumstances. Dear reader, I know that you love your children and grandchildren; I know you want the best for our nation. Then what should we do? The Old Testament clearly shows that a nation whose people serve God and teach their children to serve God spare themselves of many heartaches. On the other hand, people who forget God, sooner or later, will find the consequences of sin destroy their nation and sadly the children will suffer as well. The choice is ours. With your children and grandchildren in mind, what will you chose?
