Entrusted With The Gospel

I Thessalonians 2:4 "On the contrary, we speak as men approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel. We are not trying to please men but God, who tests our hearts."

Has someone ever trusted you to take care of something? Perhaps they have gone on vacation and left their dog in your care. Maybe you have watched someone's children for a day or a week. Has someone given you a sum of money or a prized possession to watch for a period of time? Possibly you were given a valued piece of information and asked to keep it to yourself until the proper time. You were entrusted. The person saw you as someone responsible enough to take care of what was entrusted to your care. It was believed that they would receive the item back in great shape. If by chance the animal ran away, the child got hurt or we damaged the possession, we would be distraught by the unfortunate circumstances. We would not desire to see our trust as a failure and unpleasing to the giver.

God has entrusted Christians with the gospel. He is the one to which we are responsible. It is up to us to keep the gospel in its pure state and to share it with the world. The gospel is a precious gift to be hidden within our hearts and mind. When sharing this gospel, we must present it as it was given to us by God. Paul fully realized that the trust was from God. Man may not be happy with some of its requirements but we have no right to change it. We will answer to God. He will be our judge and not any man. Are we faithful to what has been entrusted to us? Will God be pleased with our safe keeping of his word?
