Matthew 9:9 "As Jesus went on from there, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax collector's booth. "Follow me," he told him, and Matthew got up and followed him "

When Matthew first met the Lord, he was a tax collector. He was employed by the Romans government and his job was to collect taxes from the Jewish people. Matthew full well knew he was a sinner. Just four verses after this one Jesus stated, "I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners." This resonated well within the mind of Matthew. He was missing something.
