You're Wrong!

Romans 2:1 You, therefore, have no excuse, you who pass judgment on someone else, for at whatever point you judge the other, you are condemning yourself, because you who pass judgment do the same things.

The sign along the side of the road reads that the speed limit is 55. You are traveling down the highway and someone flies by you at 75. You ask, "What is wrong with that person? Can't he/she read that the sign says 55? Doesn't he/she know that the law is not to be broken? Where are the police when crazy drivers like this go by me?" And oh, by the way, when you look down your speedometer says 65mph. It is so easy to criticize someone for their actions and simply overlook our own. The speed limit may seem such a trivial example but there are numerous examples that are far from trivial. Whether travel 65 or 75, each is a law-breaker when the law reads 55.

Paul would address the Romans later in this same chapter and ask why they would condemn someone for stealing and yet they are guilty of stealing as well. Why would you preach against adultery and yet commit the same act yourself. Why do you teach others how to live and yet fail to learn the very same lessons for your life? People easily see the wrong in others while never seeing it in ourselves. If we do see it, then we are all so eager to excuse it claiming we have legitimate reasons to do something improper. As Christians, we must practice what we preach. This is not always easy but this must be our goal. When we tell someone their behavior is wrong and we are guilty of the same actions then we are wrong. Both law breakers will stand before the Great Law Giver. Let each one of us strive simply to do what God's word has taught us to do. Let's stand for truth and encourage everyone to follow it. When we fail, let's ask for forgiveness and strive to do right. Practice what you preach!
