Daily Conversions

Acts 2:47 "And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved."

When we talk about restoring the New Testament Church, there are many things to take into consideration. The disciples spent time with the apostle's doctrine and with each other. Prayer and fellowship were continuous. They were in one another's homes and shared anything and everything needed within the Christian community. Local congregations try to do these same things today and we strive to be doctrinally correct. We are far from receiving the same results they did. Daily conversions were part of the early church. Whether it was a Sunday, a Tuesday or a Friday, conversions were happening. The baptismal water hole constantly had the waters stirred.
