It is sad to say and hard to believe but summer time is slowly winding down. It seems this season gets shorter every year. However, it has not been in vain and we at South Gate have a lot to show for it. So far we have had an incredible summer series packed full of great lessons each week. Plus we have had several visitors each night as a result of it being on Tuesday nights. We had a good VBS, which of course was our first one in the new building. I saw it as a slight test run for years to come as far as how things work out. There have been lots of youth activities and trips this summer. The greatest part so far and definitely the highlight was the FIVE responses to the gospel from our teens last week. Three came during the Horizons trip to Freed-Hardeman and at Midnight Sunday morning two more souls were baptized into Christ. Those responses are enough to make our hearts rejoice for a long time to come. Some congregations might not have five responses in an entire year, yet alone one week. With this in mind, I think there are a few things that we need to keep in mind.

First, the gospel is still powerful! The Blood of Christ still flows! The forgiveness is still available. The gospel is still relevant and needed in this world. Teens still have a heart for Christ and the church (Rm. 1:16-17; Eph. 1:7).

Second, youth ministry works. Often people think of youth ministry as baby sitting a lot of teens and playing games. However, I work closely enough with our Youth Minister to know that he spends a lot of time and effort planning, coordinating and conducting these events and the whole youth program. It has grown by leaps and bounds in the past four years. This is in large part because of the WORK of Jody Pritchett. Teens need someone to help minster to them and guide them in their walk with Christ. We should be thankful for Jody and this program.

Third, the youth are NOT the church of tomorrow, they are the church of today. Right now many of our teens are part of the church, just like our adults. They are not a separate entity but still part of this congregation. True they do many activities most adults do not want to do (e.g., late night devotionals, week long trips). Yet, there are many things the adults do the teens do not want to do either (e.g., prime timers trips). With this said we are all part of the same body (1 Cor. 12) and we all have something to offer no matter what age we are. For that I will continue to rejoice.

#### Is That Your Own Idea?

John 18:34 "Is that your own idea," Jesus asked, "or did others talk to you about me?"

Pilate was playing the role as the jury and the judge as Jesus stood before him. Judgment was to be based upon the truth. Jesus wanted to know how Pilate was coming up with his information. Were these thoughts from his mind? Was he just listening to the Jewish people surrounding him? Had he really done any investigating? Jesus' life was in the hands of Pilate. Jesus wanted to know how he was arriving at his conclusions. This is a very valid question and it applies to us even today.

When it comes to doctrine, how have we arrived at our conclusions? Do we believe based upon what the preacher says? Do we base our salvation upon what we learned in our home?
